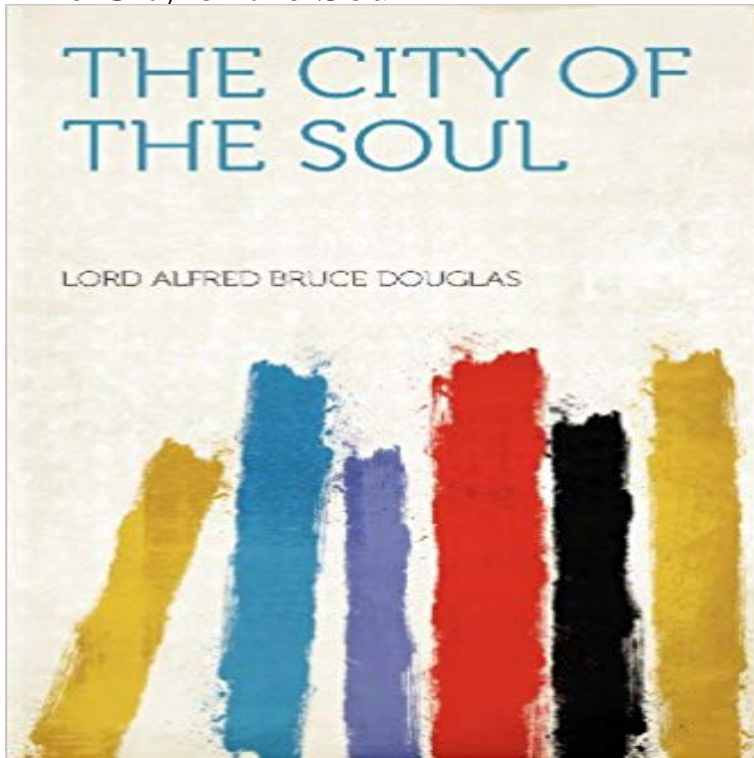


The City of the Soul
