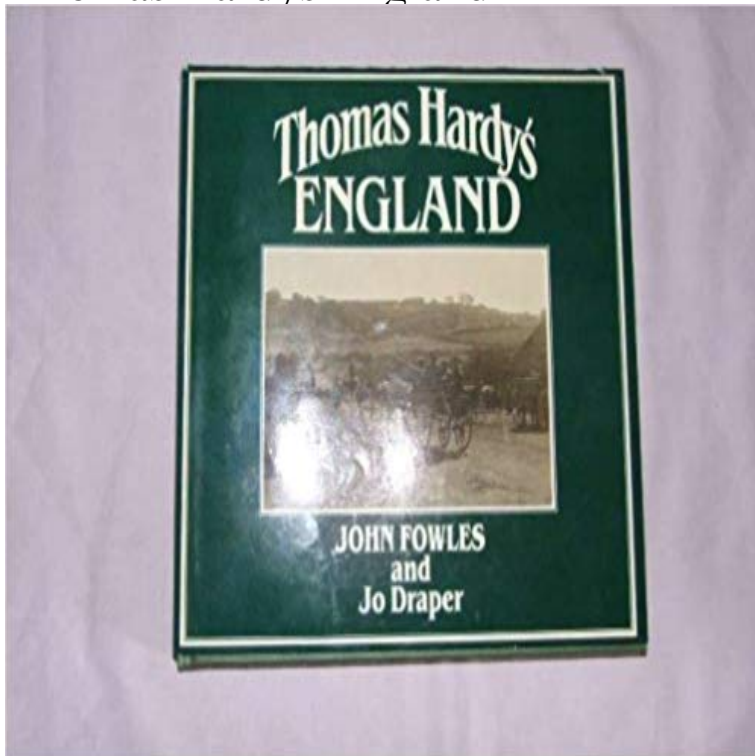


Thomas Hardys England
