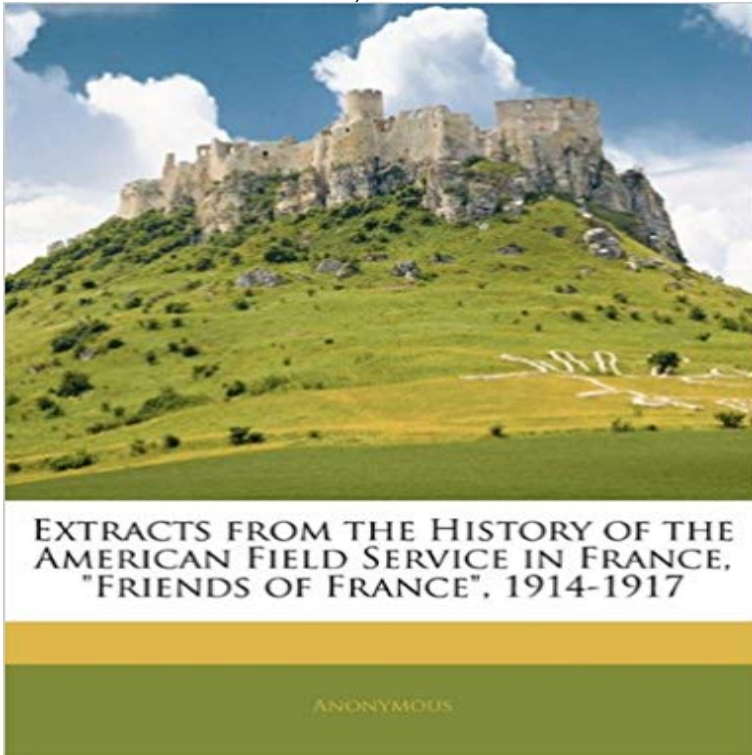


Extracts from the History of the American Field Service in France, Friends of France, 1914-1917
