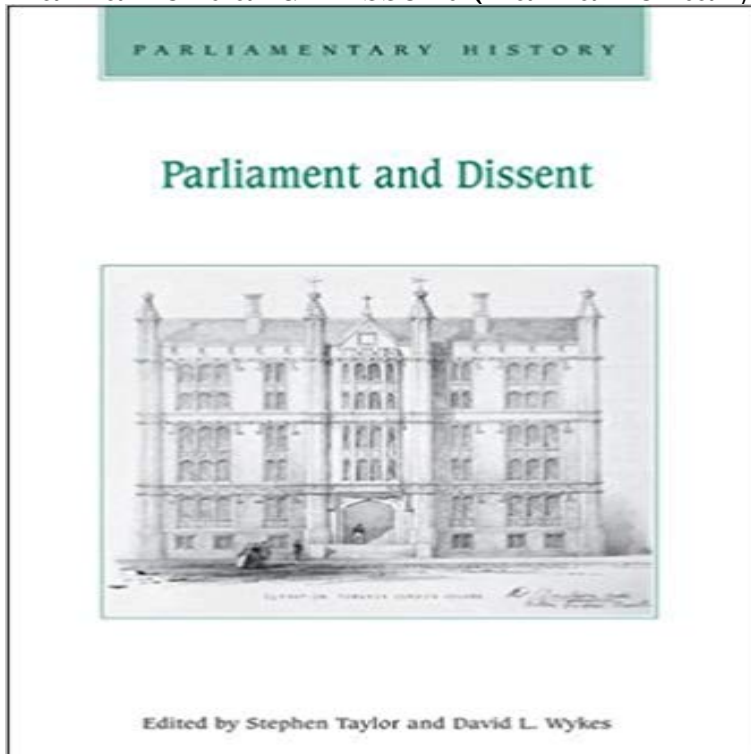


Parliament and Dissent (Parliamentary History)
