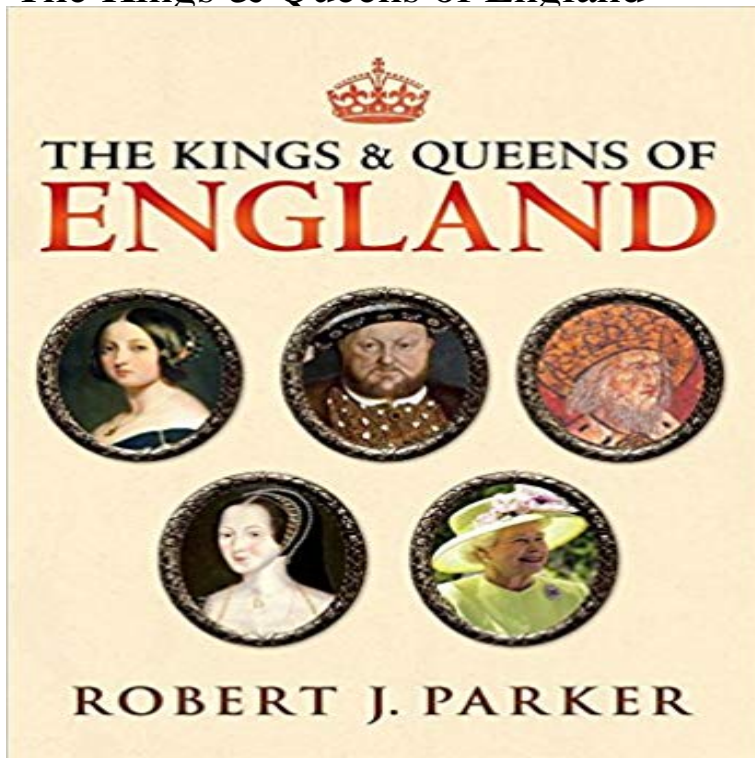


The Kings & Queens of England
