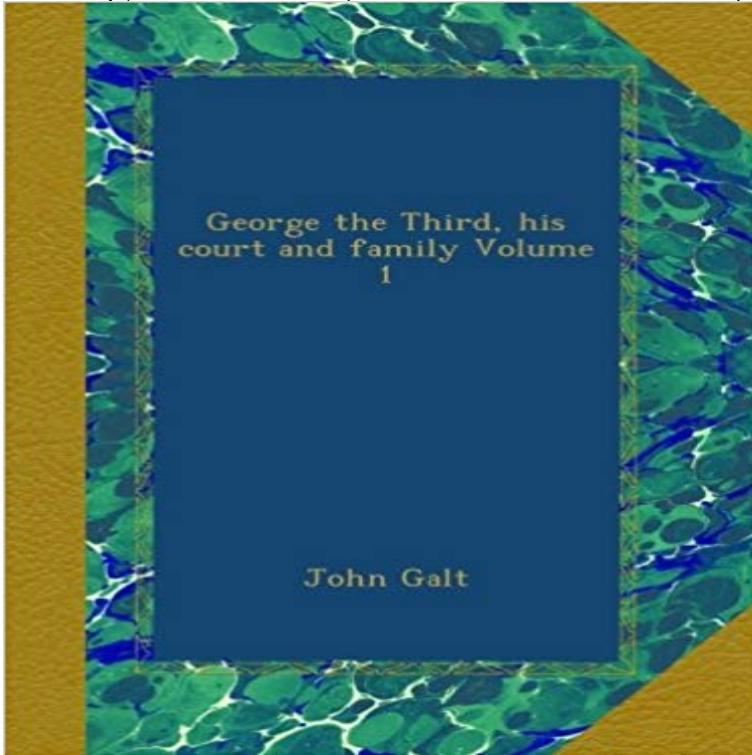


George the Third, his court and family Volume 1
