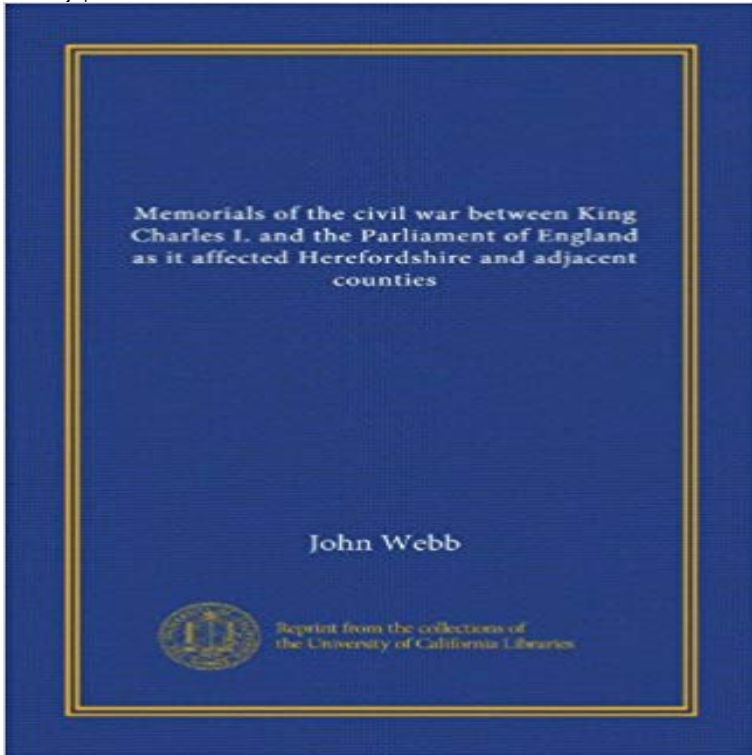


Memorials of the civil war between King Charles I. and the Parliament of England as it affected Herefordshire and adjacent counties (v.1)
