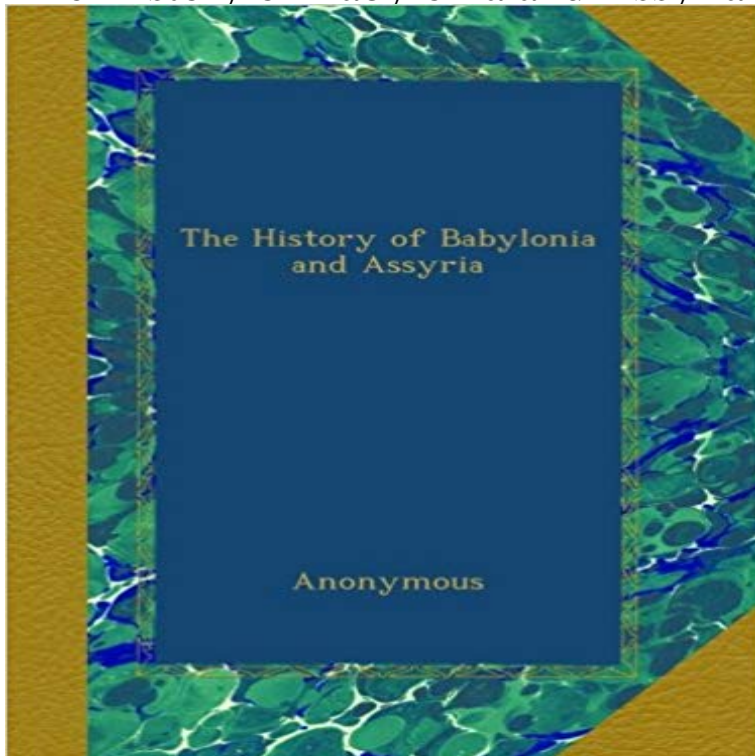


The History of Babylonia and Assyria
