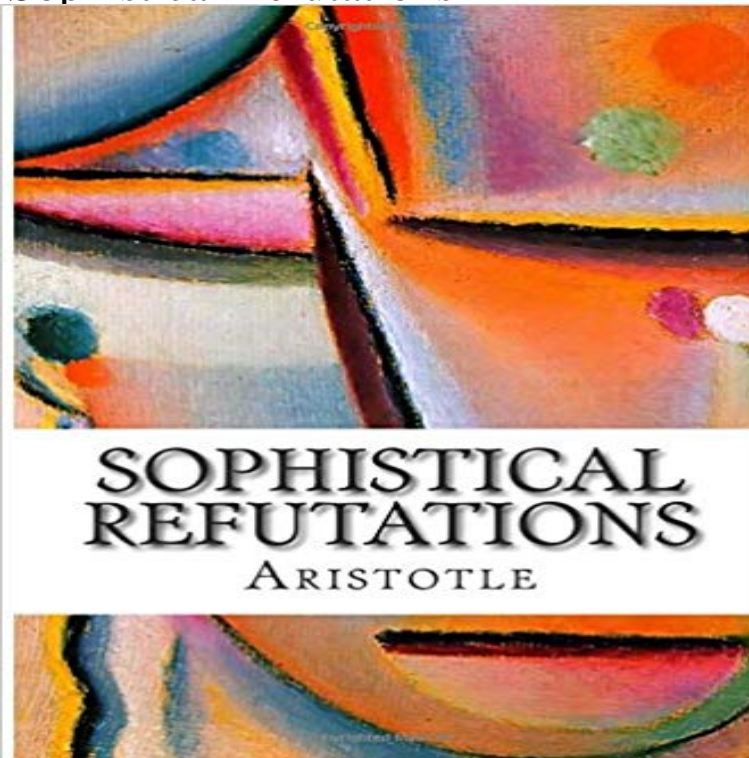


## Sophistical Refutations
