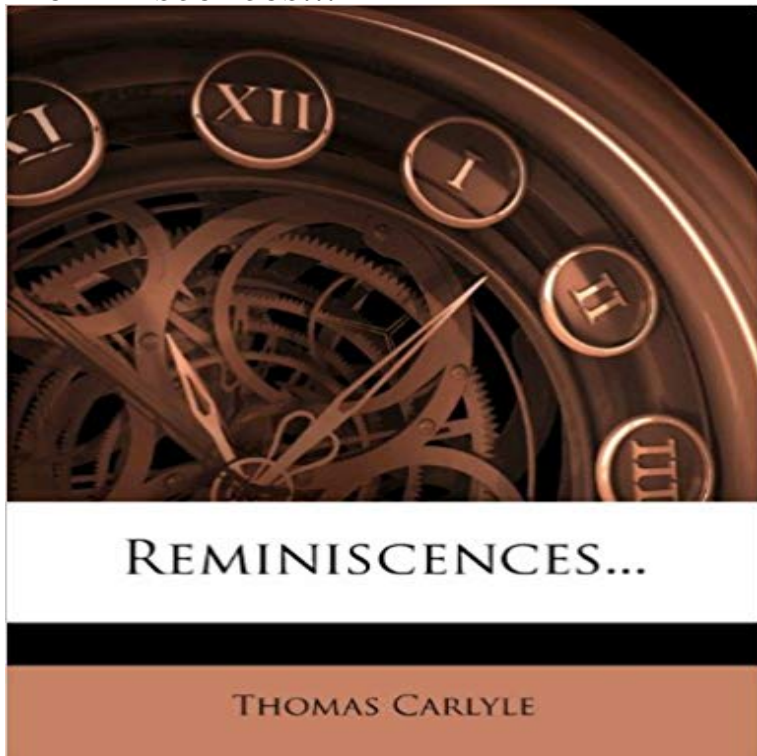


# Reminiscences...
