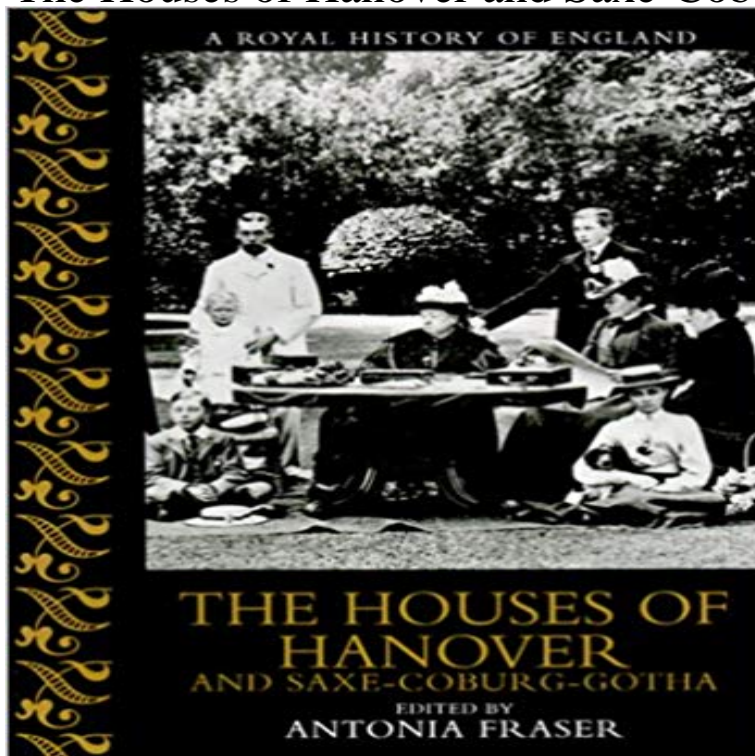


The Houses of Hanover and Saxe-Coburg-Gotha
