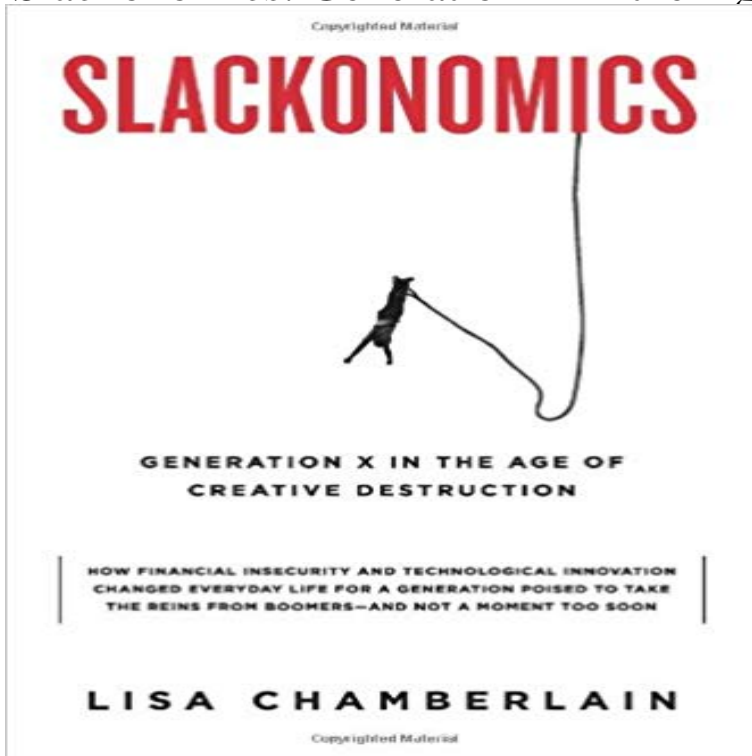


# Slackonomics: Generation X in the Age of Creative Destruction
