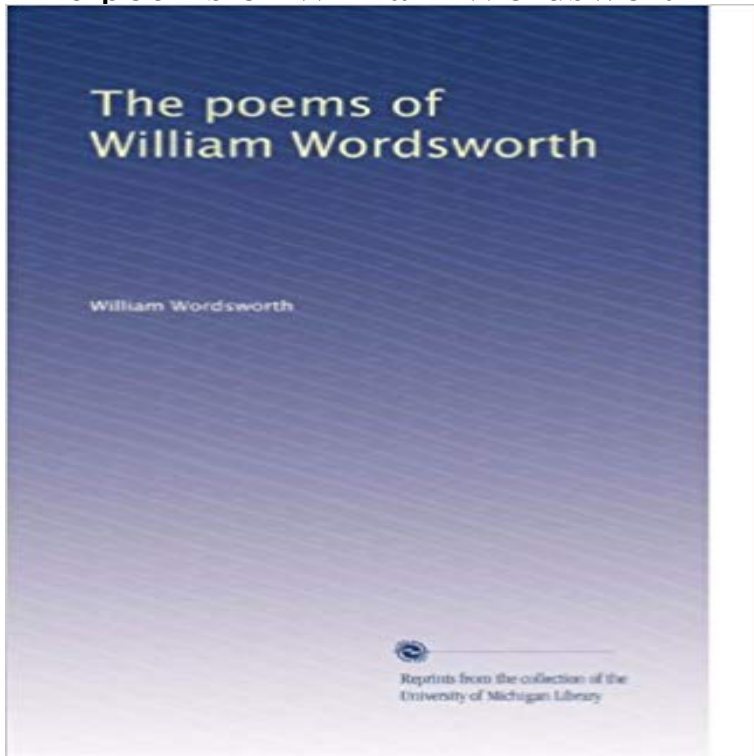


The poems of William Wordsworth
