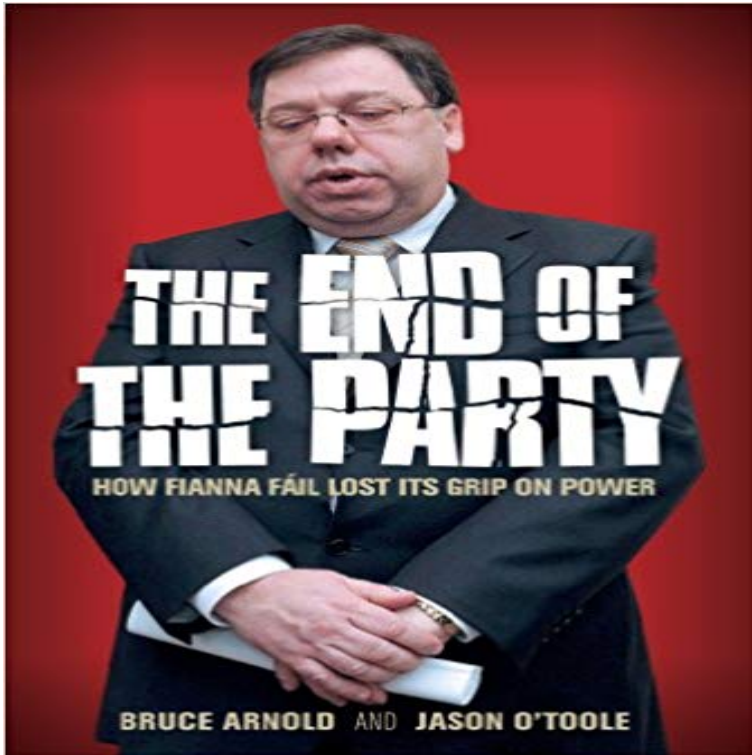


Fianna Fail : The End of the Party: How Fianna Fail Finally Lost its Grip on Power
