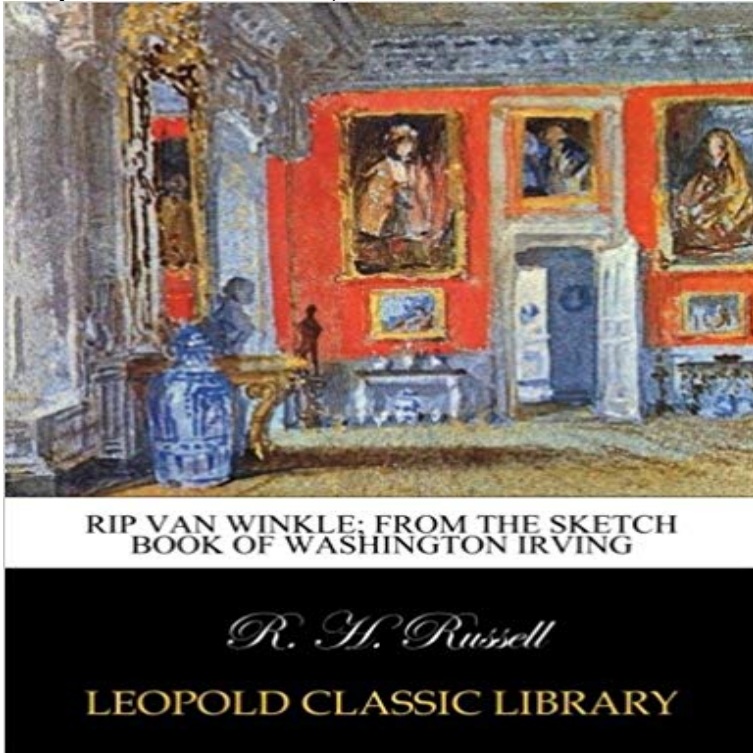


Rip Van Winkle; from The sketch book of Washington Irving
