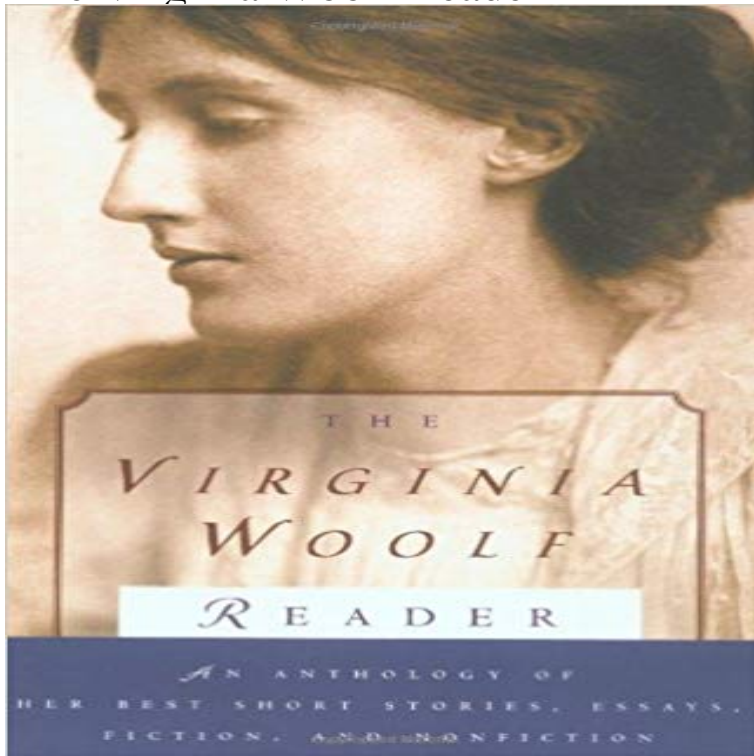


The Virginia Woolf Reader
