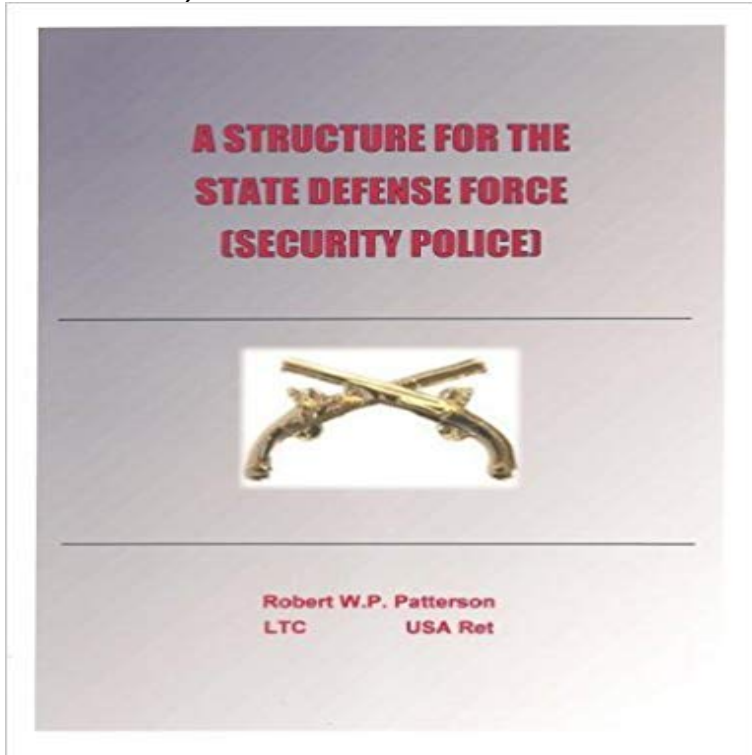


A STRUCTURE FOR THE STATE DEFENSE FORCE (SECURITY POLICE)
