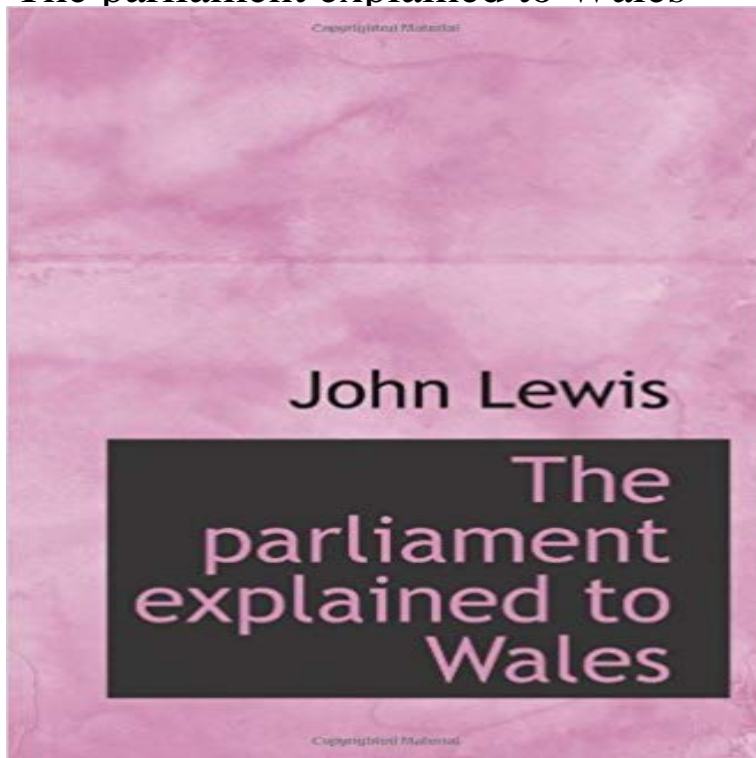


# The parliament explained to Wales
